VOLUNTEER TIPS: FOOD INTO THE HOME



Entry into a property should be a last resort.

Deliveries should be deposited on the doorstep wherever possible.



Call in advance to inform the recipient of the estimated delivery time, verify details of required access, asking them to ensure the required entrance is clear to minimise contact.



Use a **paper towel** to open doors, handle food items and place food into the fridge/freezer.



Observe social distancing at all times, between you and house occupants. Ask occupants to stay in a separate room to you at all times.



Wash or sanitise your hands and put on a face covering before entering the property. Only take what you need into the house.



Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.



Minimise number of surfaces touched, and risk of contamination, by **leaving other food items out on an accessible worktop/surface - not placing them into cupboards.**

Dispose of any bags or external packaging carefully.



Wipe down all surfaces or handles you may have touched.

Place your face covering in a zip-lock bag for disposal/washing and wash/sanitise your hands thoroughly before moving on to next contact, your vehicle or home.
