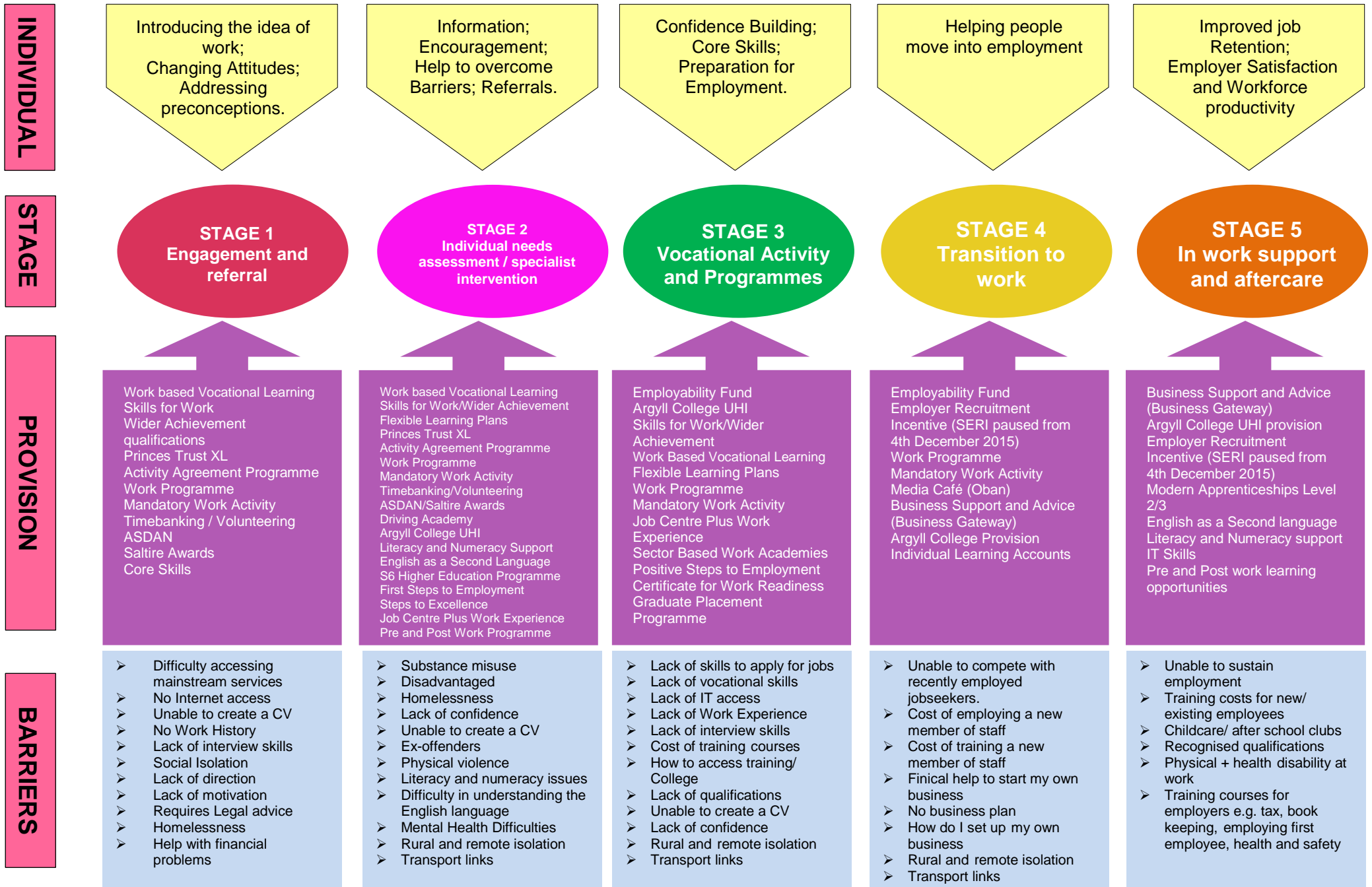
4: Job Creation
