



ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

THE ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (DUNBEG VILLAGE ROADS, DUNSTAFFNAGE CASTLE ROAD) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that on Monday 16th October 2017, Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 12 (1) (a) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 made the above mentioned Order, the effect of which will be to authorise the improvement of a private road in Dunbeg, near Oban, Argyll that enters the route of that public road known as the Dunbeg Village Roads, Dunstaffnage Castle Road.
