Need help with your housing or looking for housing in Argyll & Bute?

Did you know that HOMEArgyll offers a free online Housing Options Self-Assessment service?

This service provides advice on housing options, including:-

- Private sector housing
- Sheltered housing
- Shared Ownership
- Applying for social housing
- Homelessness

You will also be able to access useful information and links to other services including support services, money and benefit advice, employment and training, and more.

How does it work?

The online Housing Options Self-Assessment asks you for information about your current housing situation. You will then be given all the options that are relevant to your particular circumstances. The whole process should take between 10-20 minutes (or you can save part way through and revisit when convenient)

You will be able to print your personalised housing options plan or chose to have it e-mailed to you.
