Easy to reach by boat from Oban, Lismore is a lovely location to get away from it all.

With a population of around 190, this friendly island still has many Gaelic speakers and is ideal for a quiet, relaxing holiday surrounded by beautiful scenery.

There are numerous ancient historical remains on the island including many Bronze Age cairns and Iron Age duns. Tirluir Broch - which can be seen from Balnagown Croft - is one of the best preserved galleried Pictish brochs in the country.

Castle Coffin

Just 12 miles long and 1.5 miles at its widest point, Lismore is ideal for cycling (bikes can be hired on the island or in Port Appin) and offers many interesting walks with spectacular views of the sea and mountains.
