The open day is a fantastic opportunity for all the family to find out more about the Hospital and local community services that we provide all year round to support you and your family.

Caroline Henderson, Local Manager for the hospital, said:

“Lorn & Islands Hospital provides a wide range of health and social care services for the people of Oban and surrounding areas and on most occasions the only time that the public actually get to see for themselves what services we provide is when they are either treated here or are visiting friends or family.

“The hospital belongs to the community so we felt it was important that the public had an opportunity to pop in and meet many of the health and social care professionals who provide services on a daily basis both within the hospital and in the wider community.

“We have therefore decided to arrange an Open Day in the hospital on Saturday 28th October from 2pm – 4pm and we would be delighted if members of the community came along on the day. There is no need to book, just turn up on the day.

“We will have a range of stalls and displays, and entry will be by the outpatient services door. Many of our staff, as well as representatives from our partner organisations in the public sector and the Third Sector, will be there to discuss their roles and what services they provide.

“Finally, it is also important to highlight that the day to day business of the hospital will obviously be continuing as normal during the Open Day period so access to some departments will not be possible. Members of the public will not be able to visit the inpatient wards unless they are there to visit one of our patients.”
