Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of a medical emergency that will prevent a voter from going to the polling station or for work/service/coronavirus reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Thursday 18 March 2021. The medical emergency must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 10 March. To apply on the grounds of work/service or in relation to

coronavirus, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on **Wednesday 10 March 2021**.
