I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 9 - Lomond North. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 6,257 and the number of ballot papers received was 3,236 giving a percentage turnout of 51.7%. There were 38 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 800.
