**ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(UC59 RAF MACHRIHANISH ROAD)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2019**



On Monday 1st July 2019 Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on that length of the RAF Machrihanish Road (Unclassified No. 059) which extends from its junction with the Machrihanish Business Park Access Road to its junction with the A83 Tarbet – Lochgilphead – Campbeltown Trunk Road.

This restriction is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public whilst wind turbine components are being transported from CS Wind at Machrihanish Business Park to Campbeltown Harbour. The prohibition will be in operation from 0000 hours on Monday 15th July 2019 to 2359 hours on Sunday 15th December 2019 or until it is no longer required, whichever is the earliest but will only have effect when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

Exceptions will apply to any vehicle which is:

- a) being driven for the purpose of the wind turbine transportations;
- b) being driven at the direction, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.
