## ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (PIER ROAD, LUSS)(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2019

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), and having complied with the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, being satisfied that traffic, should be restricted to permit the works, hereby makes the following Order: -

- This Order may be cited as the "Argyll and Bute Council (Pier Road, Luss)(Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2019" and will be effective when indicated by signs, from 0001 hours on Monday 11th March to 2359 hours on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2019 or until such time as the works are complete, whichever may be the earliest.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Subject to Article 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on both sides of that length of Pier Road, Luss, from a point 100 metres or thereby east of its junction with the Old A82 Road extending in an easterly direction to a point 25 metres or thereby east of its junction with Church Road a distance of 80 metres or thereby.
- 4. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle, which is a vehicle associated with the works.
