

ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (COTTONMILL LANE, ROTHESAY)(STOPPING UP) ORDER 2019

Argyll and Bute Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 68(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having considered that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order have become unnecessary and being satisfied that no alternative road is necessary, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the “Argyll and Bute Council (Cottonmill Lane, Rothesay) (Stopping Up) Order 2019” and shall come into operation on Monday the Eleventh day of February, Two Thousand and Nineteen.
2. The stopping up of this length of road in Rothesay in the Isle of Bute area of Argyll and Bute specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby ordered.
3. Where there is, immediately before the date on which the said length of road is stopped up under this Order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across that length of road for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking the said statutory undertakers shall, after the commencement of this Order continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.

SCHEDULE

Length of road in Argyll and Bute to be stopped up

That length of Cottonmill Lane, Rothesay (U81), shown zebra hatched and marked A-B on Drawing Number T455, extending from a point 62 metres or thereby west of its junction with High Street (B881) in a westerly direction for a distance of 17.8 metres or thereby, including the footways.
