

**ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(DUNOON TOWN CENTRE)(SPECIAL EVENT)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2019**

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by The Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, and of the other enabling powers, being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule hereto should be prohibited or restricted for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a cycling event in Dunoon, and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practical for the event to be held otherwise than on a road, and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under Section 16(B)(6)(b) of the said Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the “Argyll and Bute Council (Dunoon Town Centre)(Special Event) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2019” and shall have effect during the hours specified in Schedules 1 and 2 on **Saturday 28th September 2019**.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall for the interpretation of the Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Subject to Article 5 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sections of road as described in Schedule 1 to this Order at the times indicated.
4. Subject to Article 5 of this Order, no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of road as described in Schedule 2 to this Order at the times indicated.
5. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle which is:
 - (a) associated with the event;
 - (b) being driven upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform;
 - (c) being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

Schedule 1
No waiting at any time
0001 hours to 1600 hours

Ferry Brae	Both sides between its junction with Argyll Street and its junction with School Brae.
School Brae	On the east side between its junction with Ferry Brae and its junction with Kirk Brae.

Schedule 2
Prohibition of Traffic

(a) 0800 hours to 1600 hours

Argyll Street	From its junction with the A815 Alexandra Parade, extending in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Ferry Brae, a distance of 168 metres or thereby.
School Brae	From its junction with Ferry Brae extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 43 metres or thereby.
Kirk Brae	The entire length

(b) 1700 hours to 1930 hours

Pier Esplanade	From its junction with Argyll Street, extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 200 metres or thereby.
