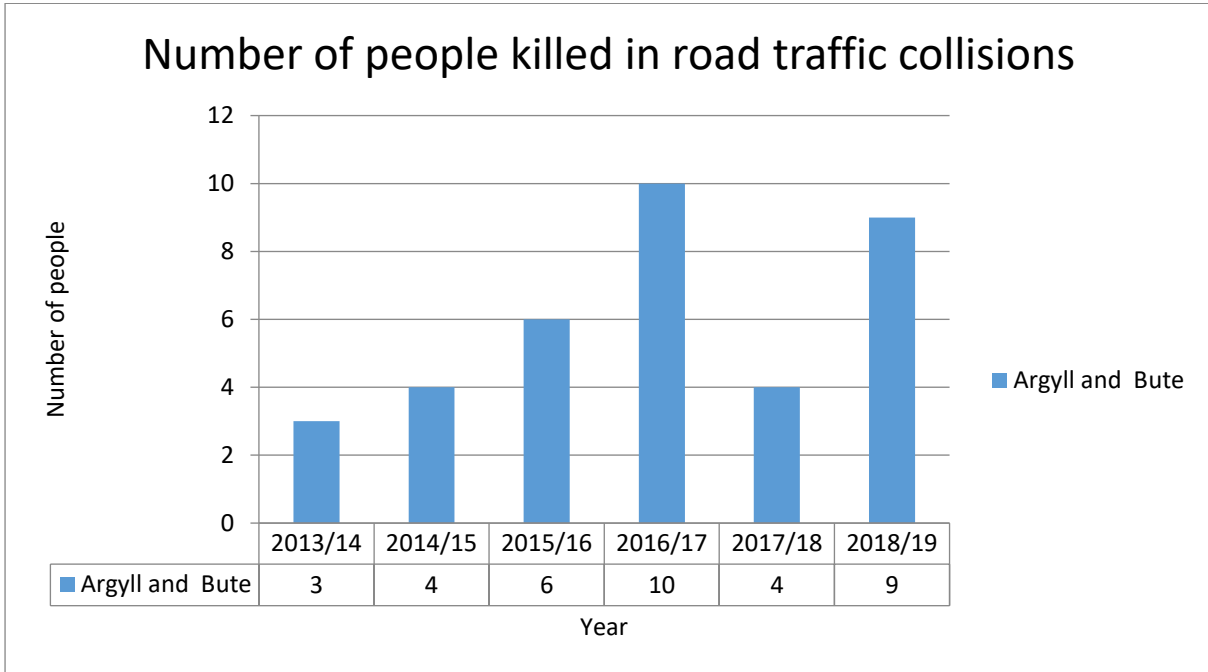

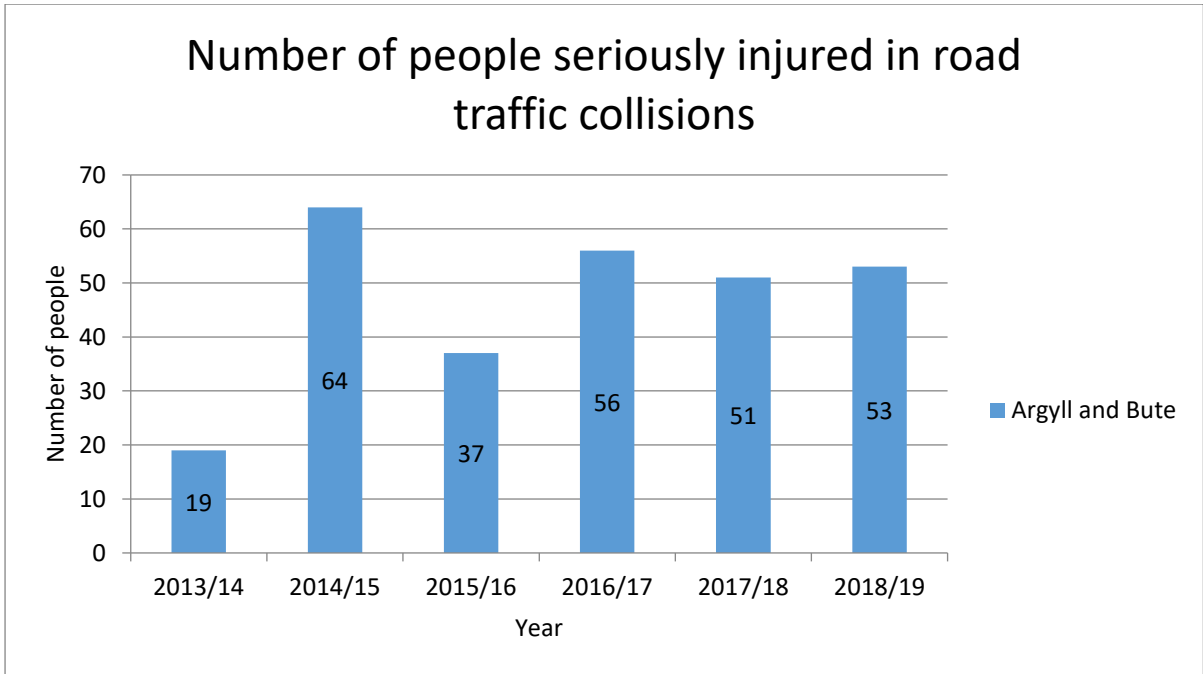


9 people were killed in road traffic collisions in 2018/19, an increase of 5 on the previous year.

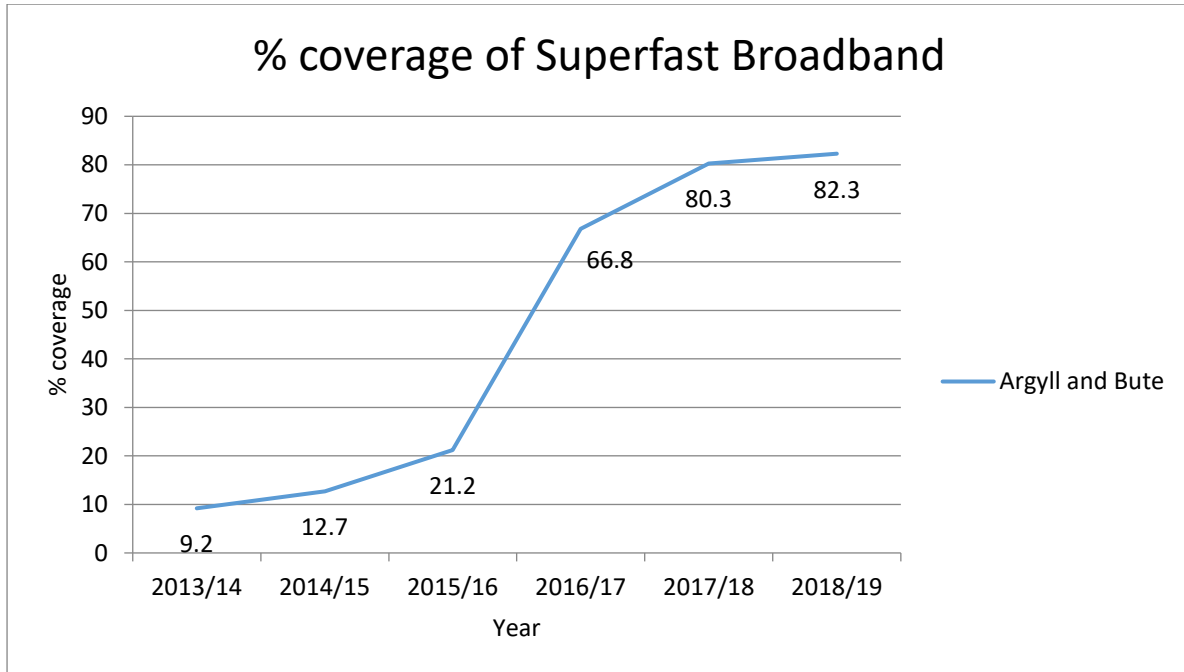


44 people were seriously injured in road traffic collisions to end FQ3 2018/19. This is a decrease from the previous year's figures.

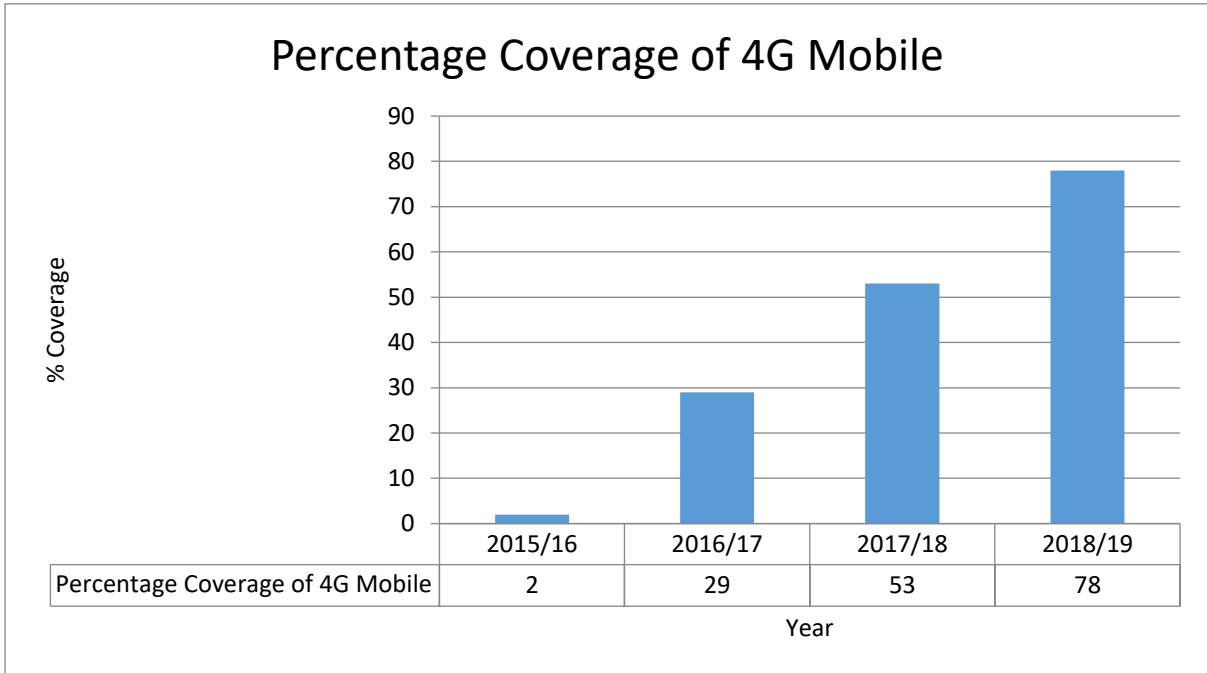


By March 2019, 82.3% of Argyll and Bute had access to superfast broadband. Superfast broadband is defined as a speed greater than 24 Mbps.

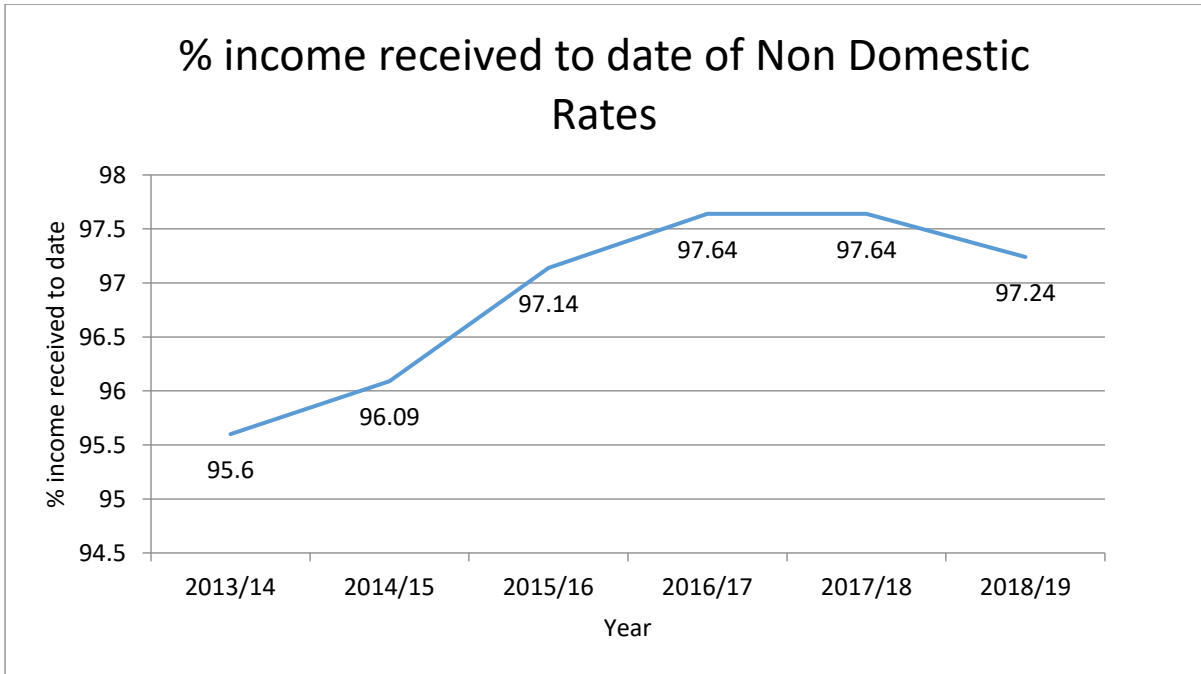


The 4G Mobile coverage in Argyll and Bute in March 2019 is 78%, this is an increase from the previous year.

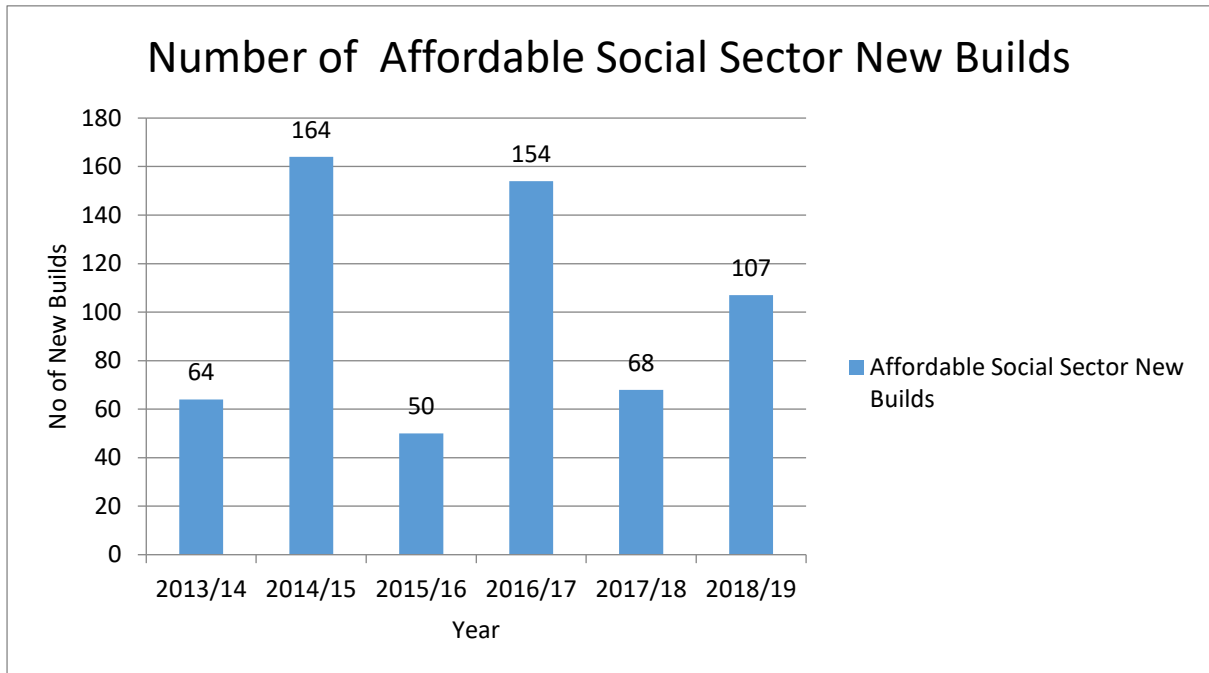


97.24% of Non Domestic Rates income was received in the 2018/19 financial year. This is against a target of 97%.
