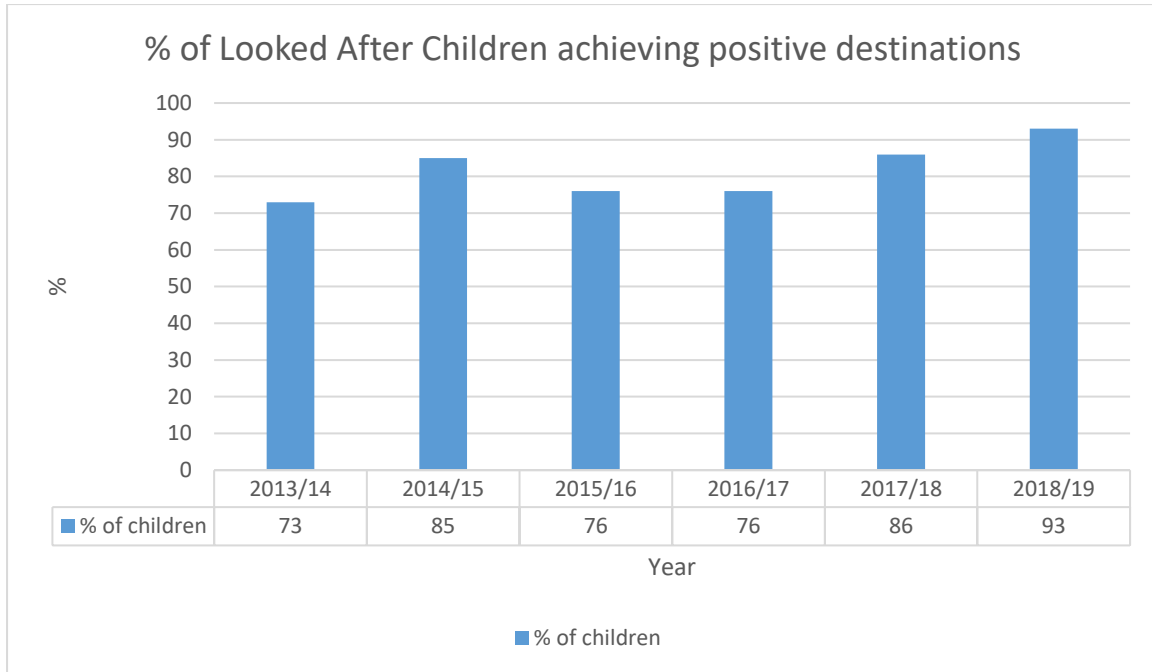

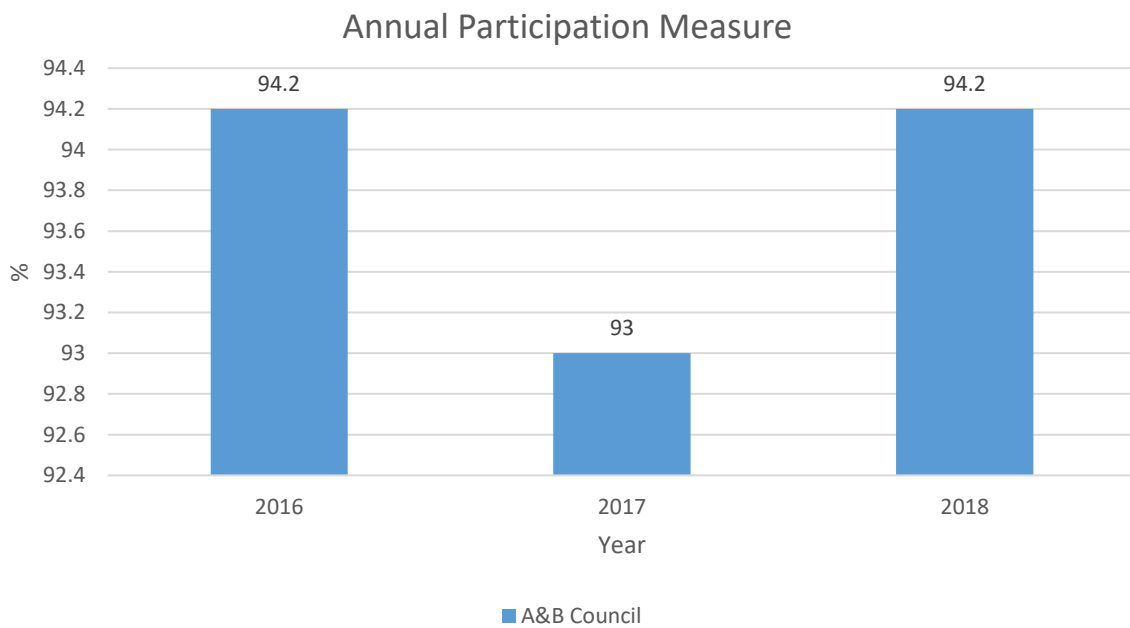
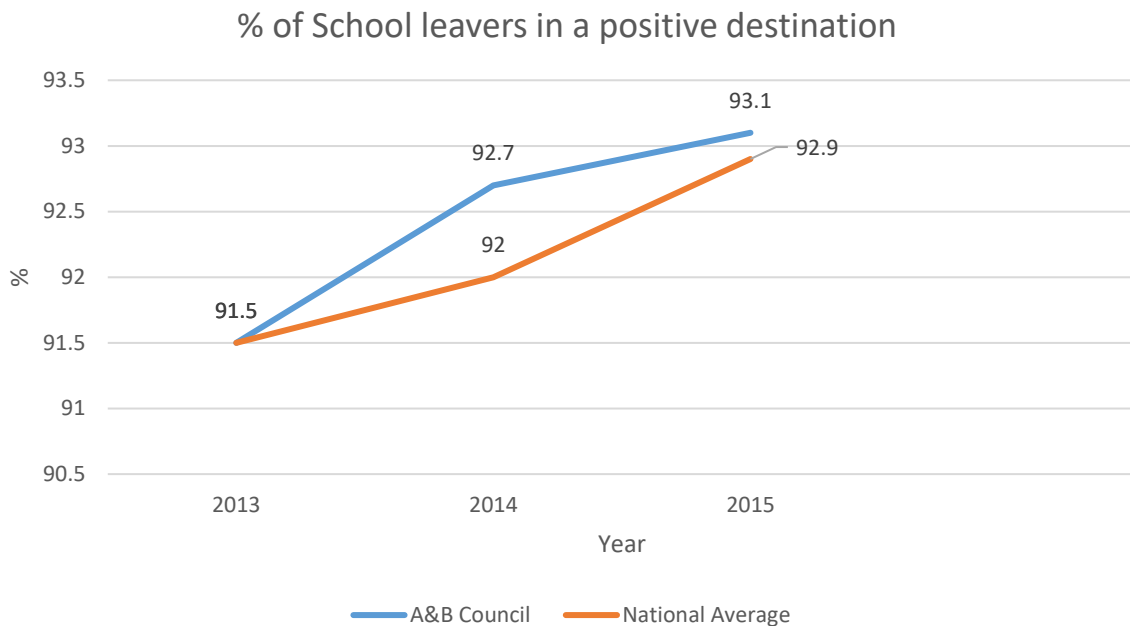


93% of Looked After Children achieved a positive destination in the 2018/19 financial year.

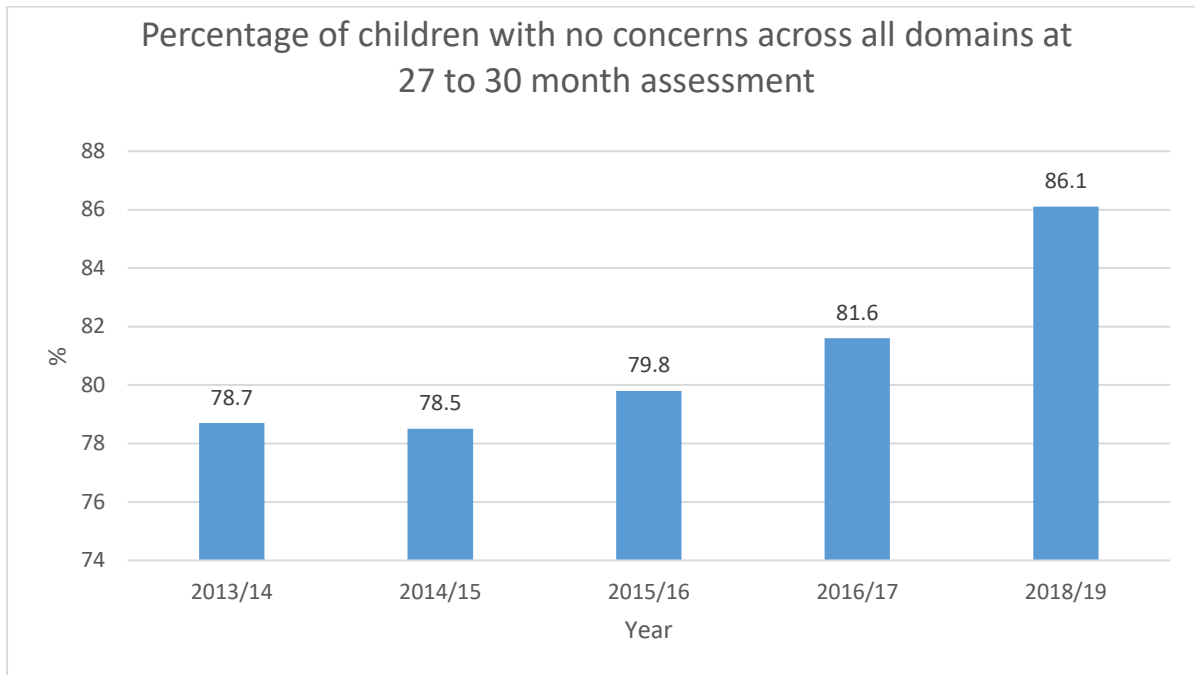

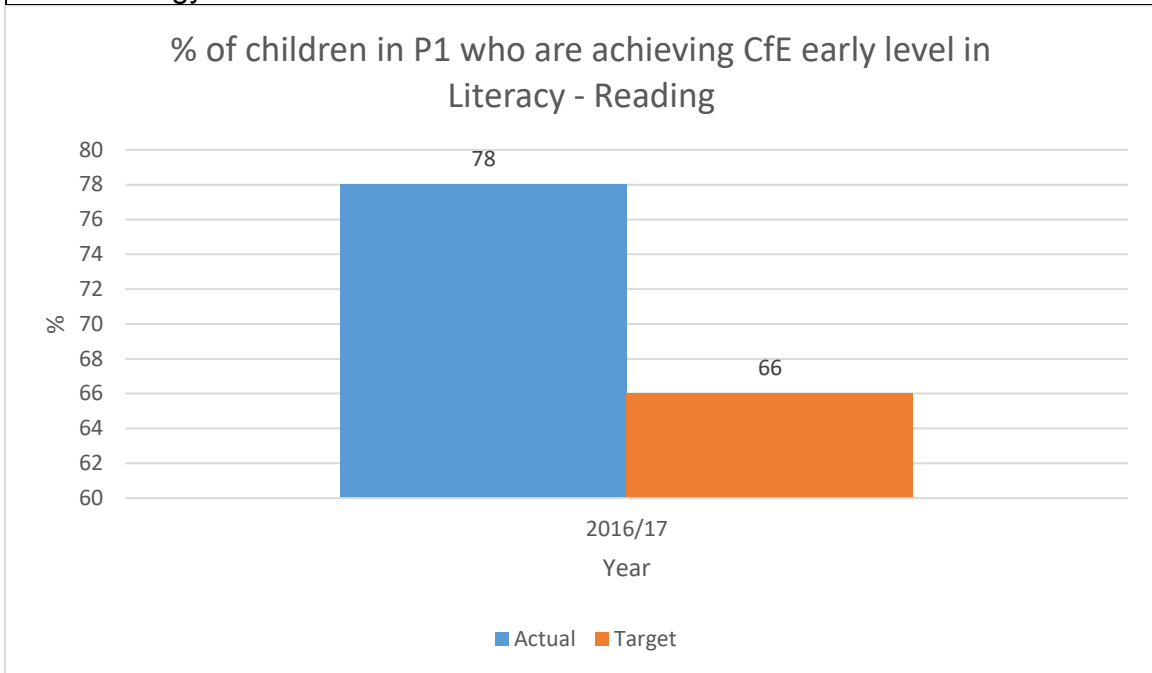


86.1% of children have no concerns at the 27 to 30 month assessment.

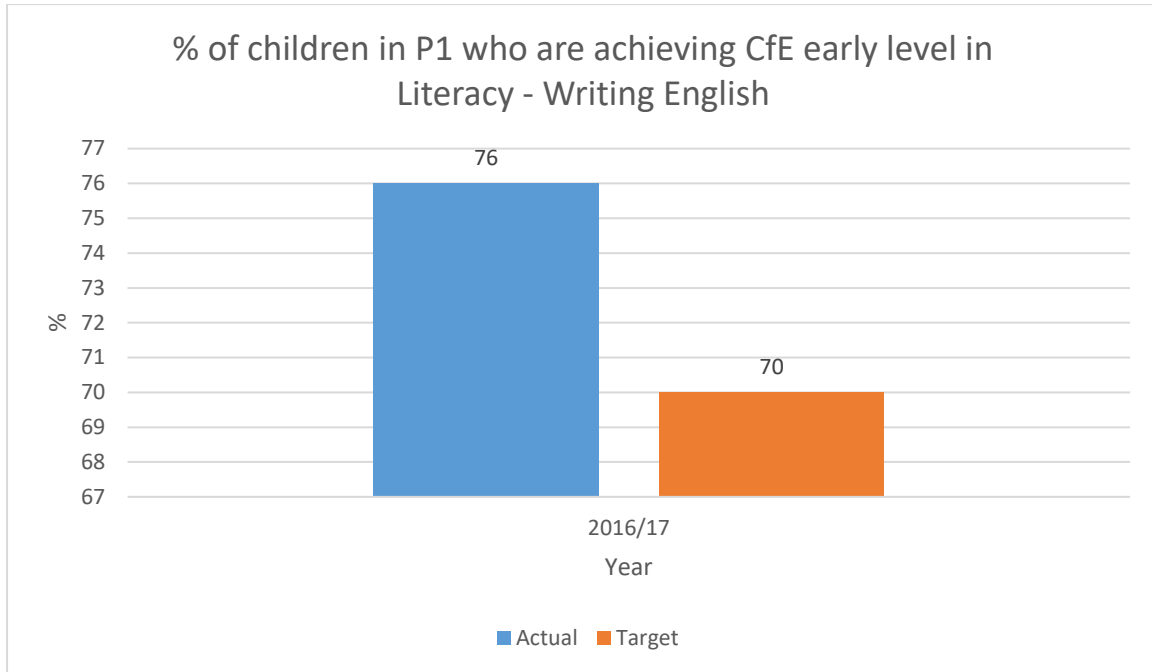

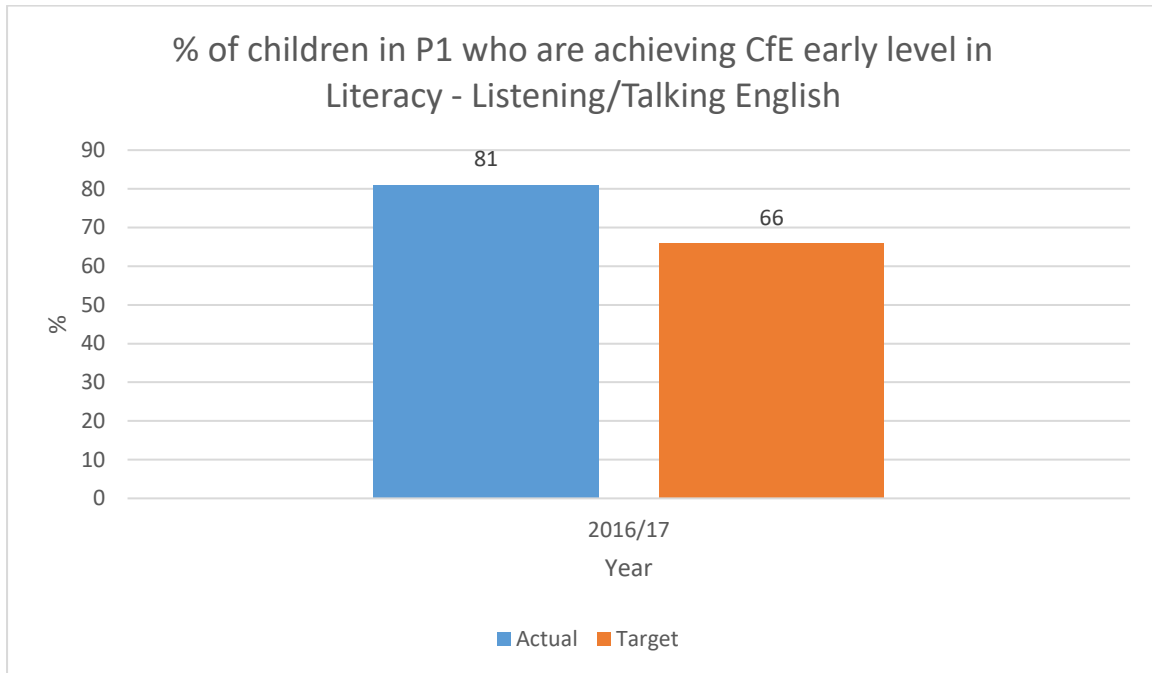

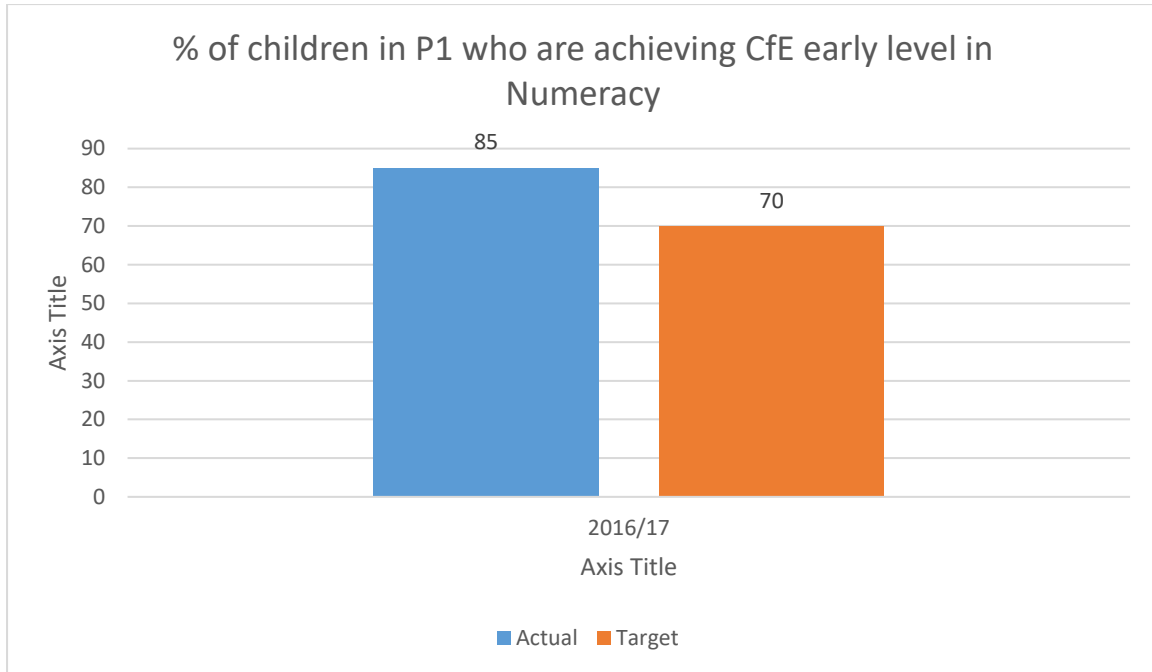

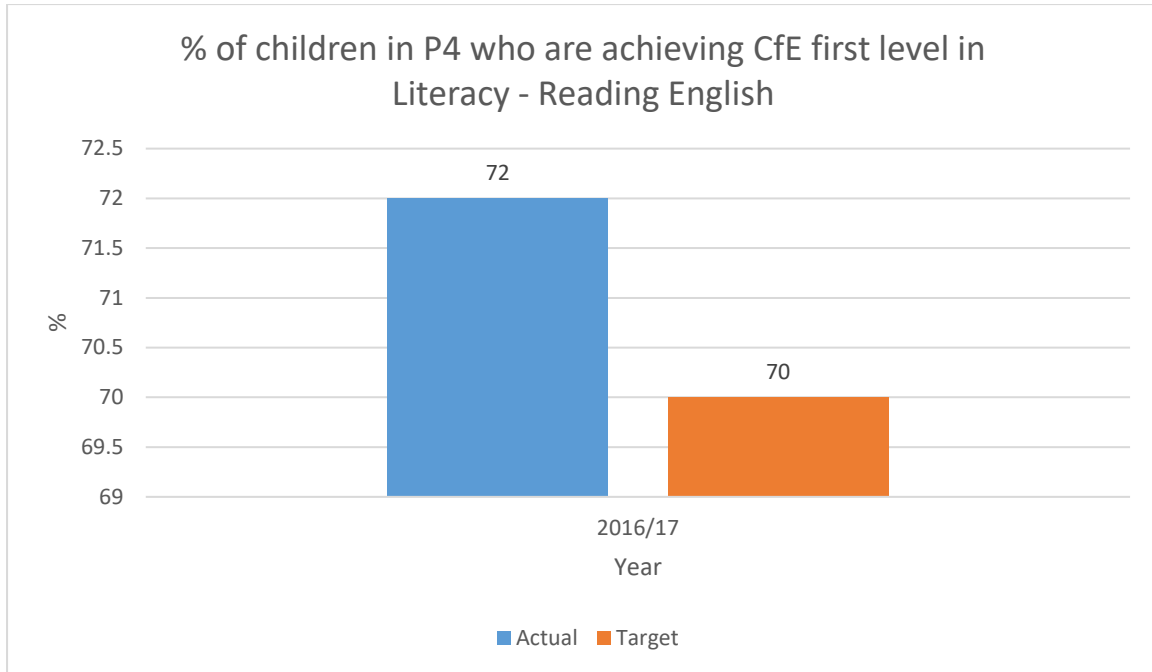

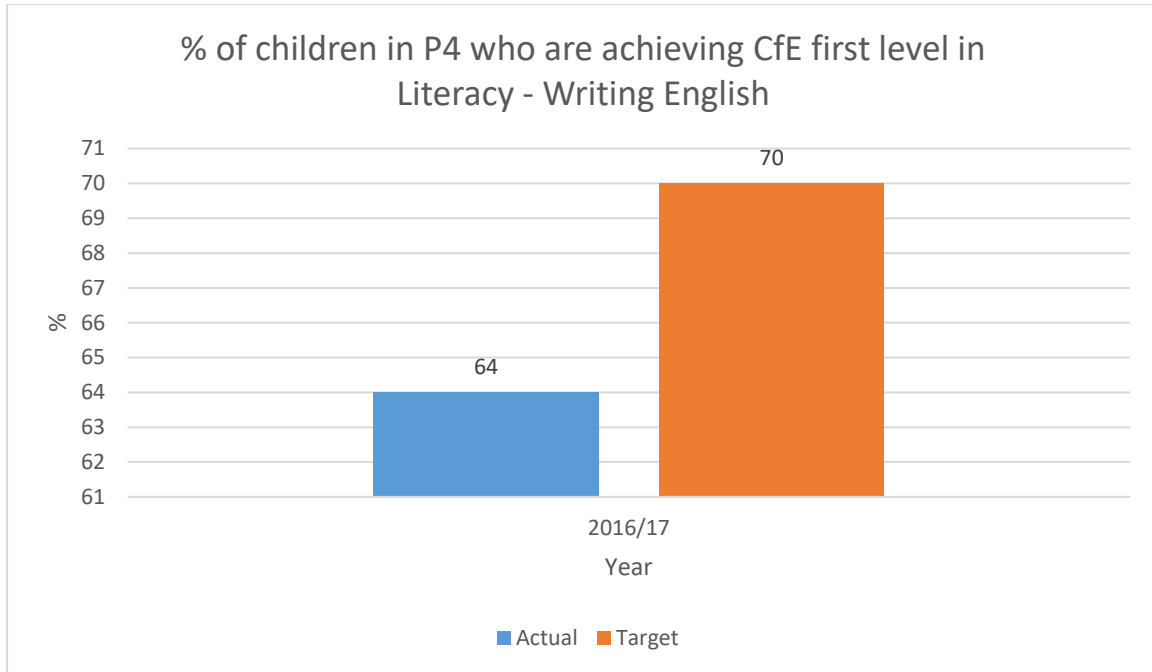

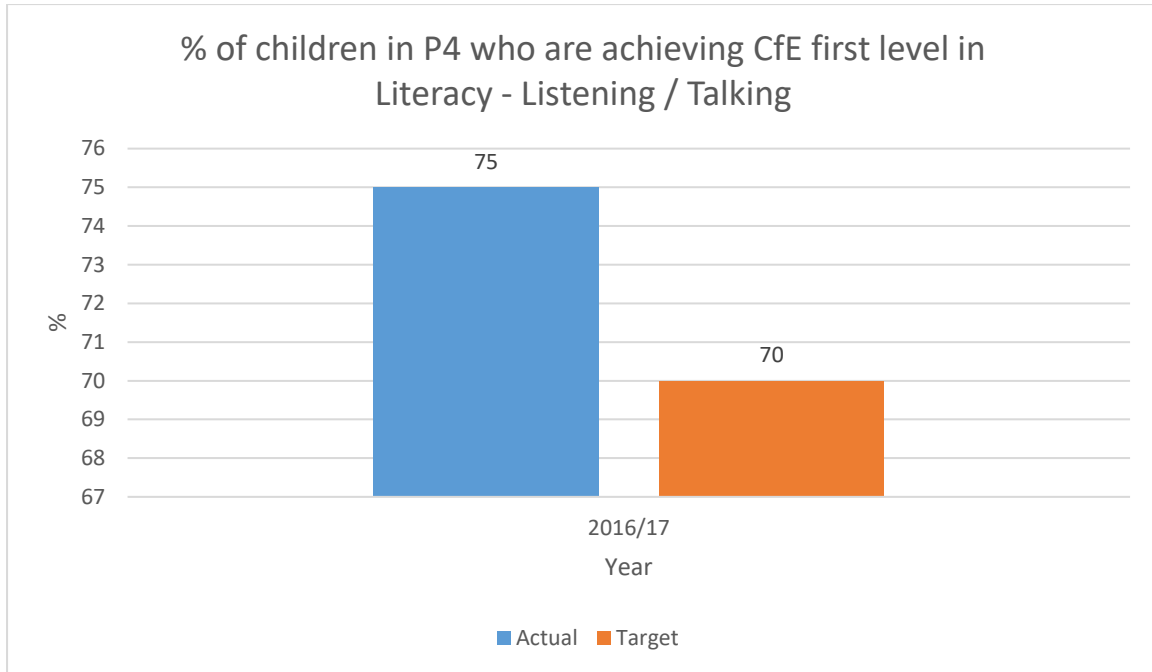

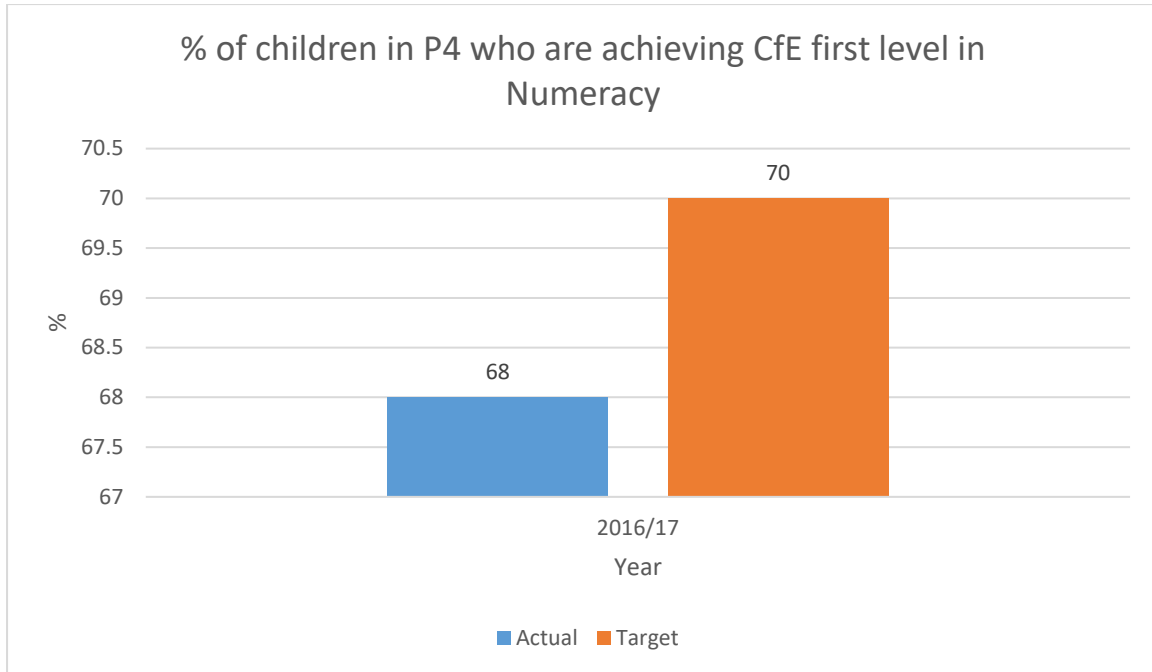

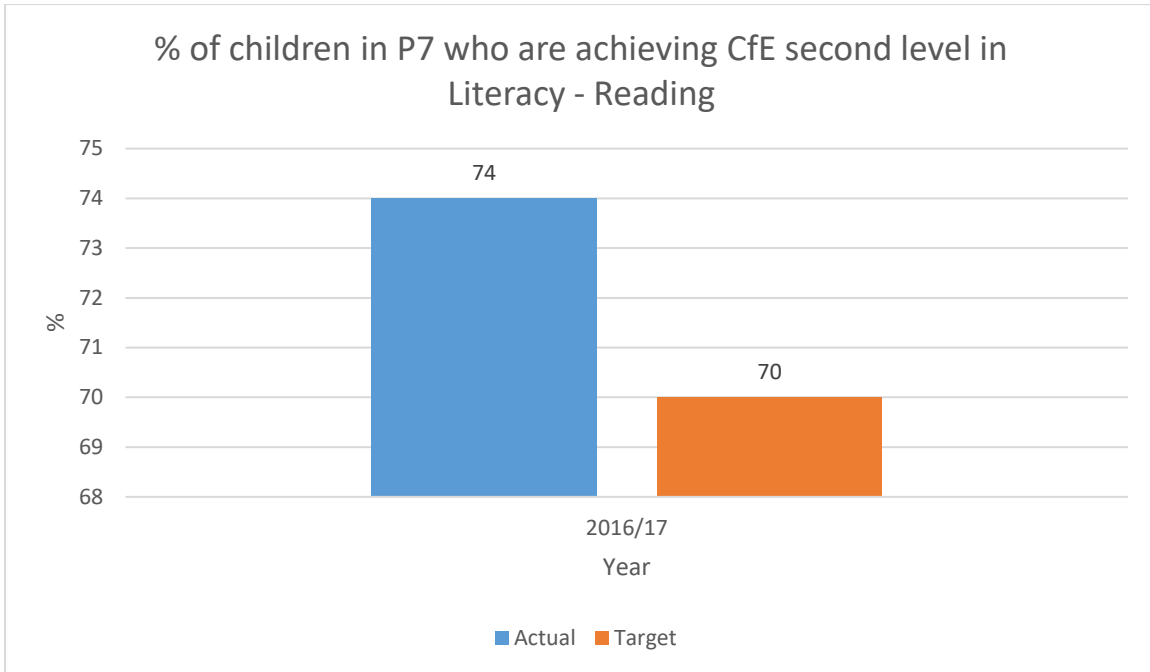

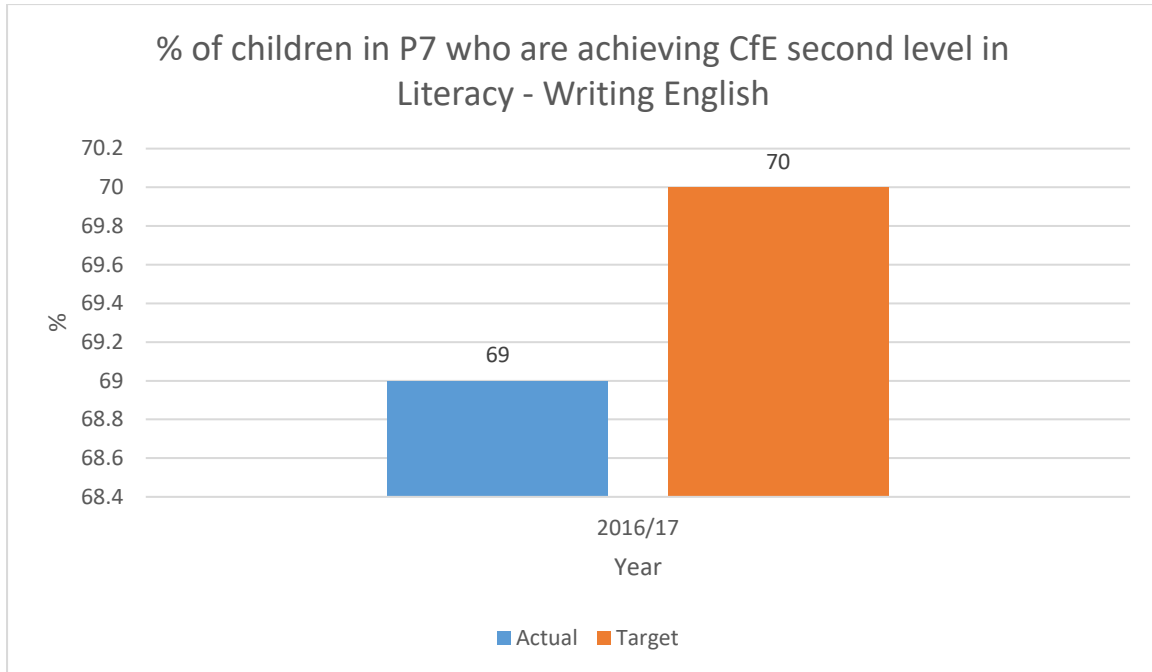

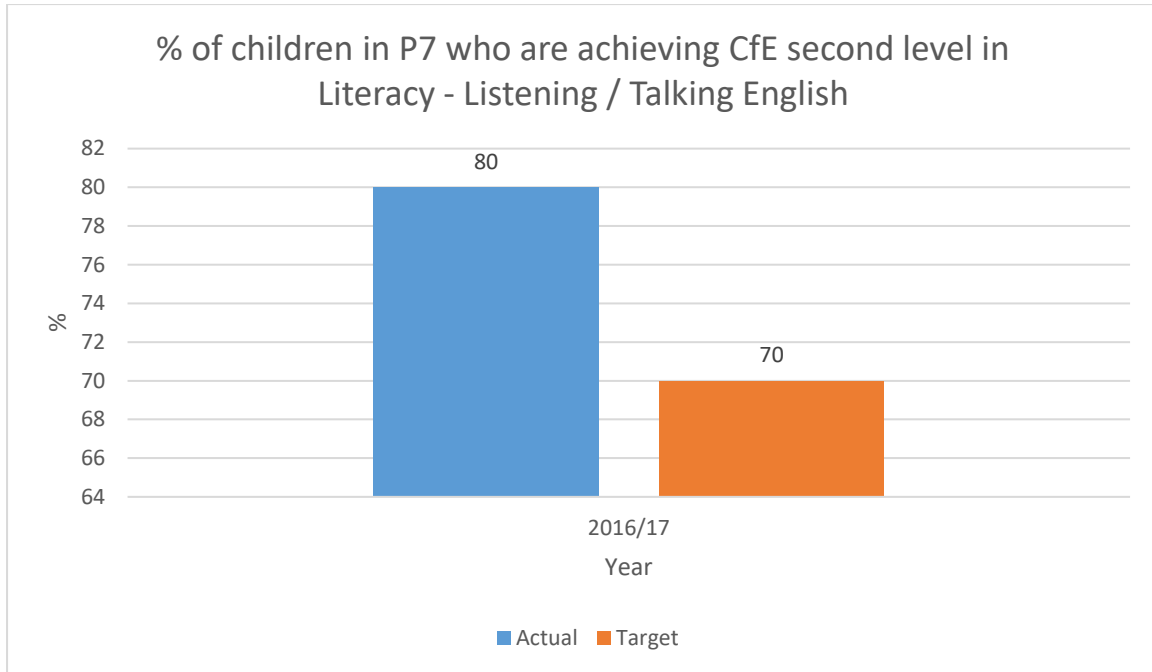

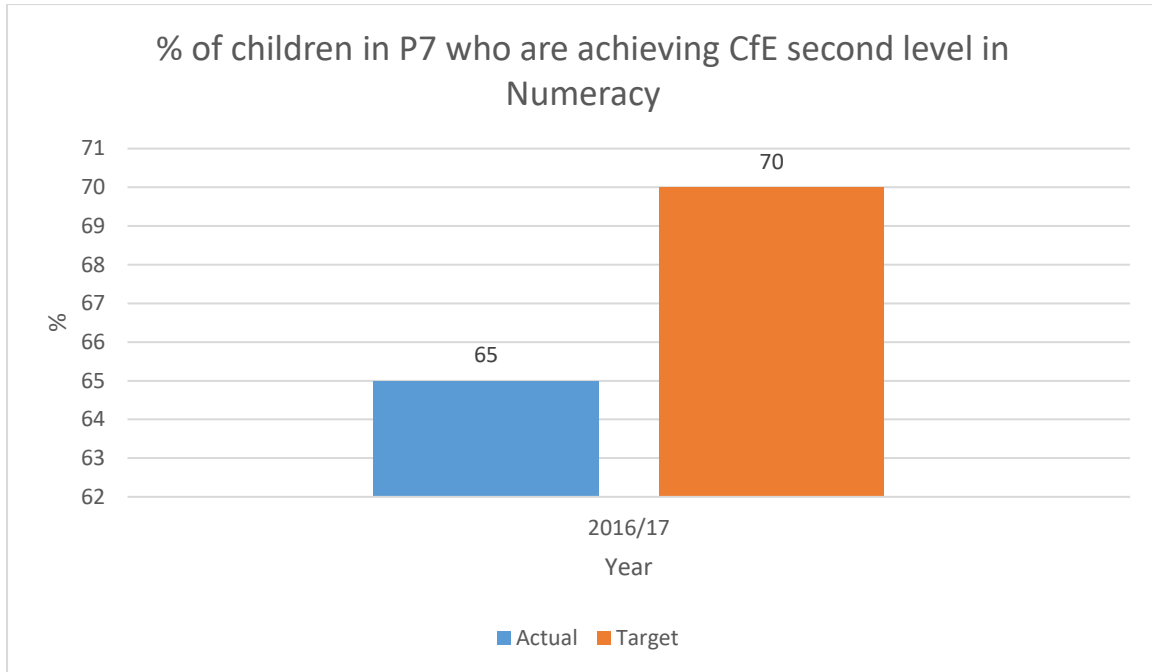

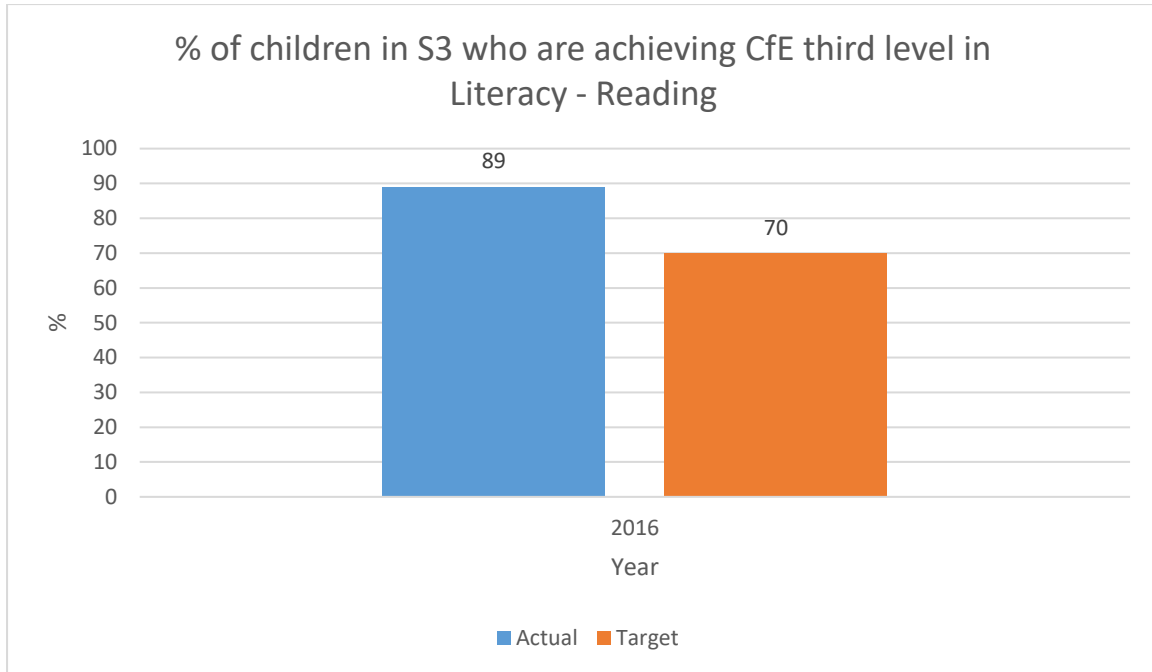

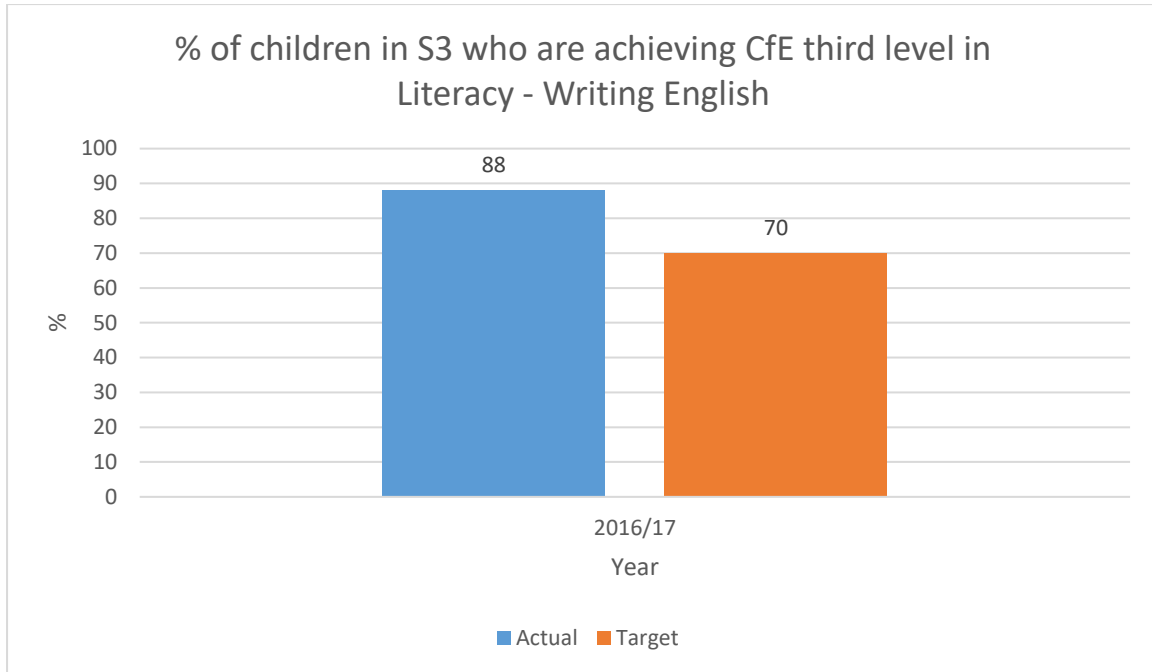

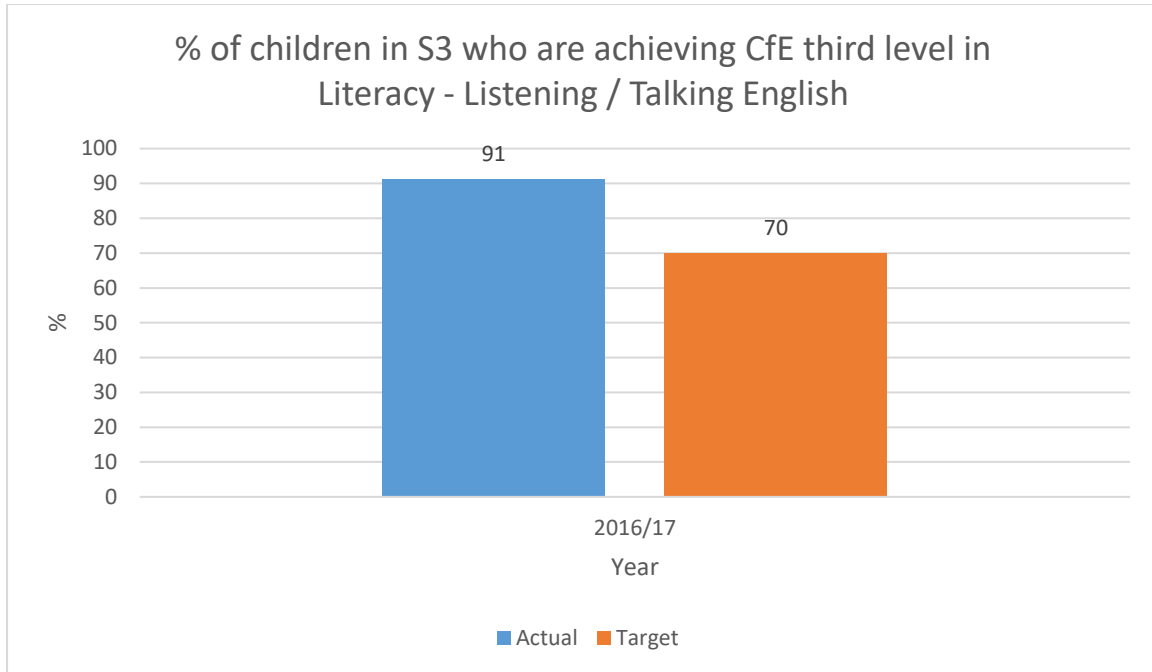

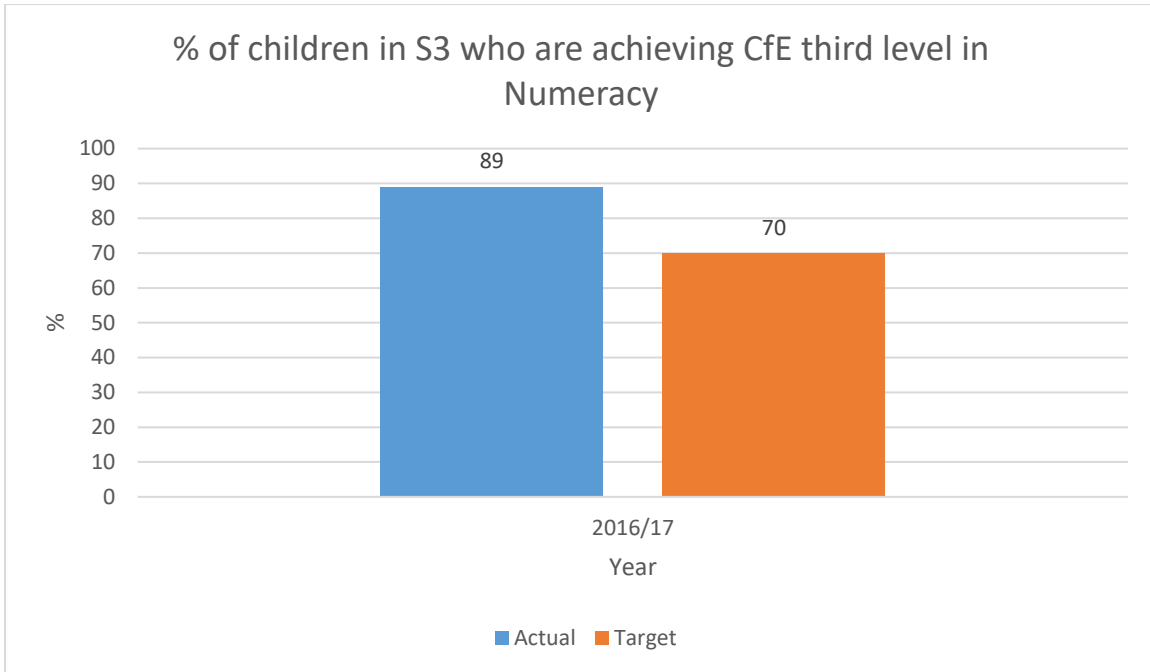
