ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (VARIOUS STREETS, CAMPBELTOWN) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2019



On Monday 11th February 2019, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, which comes into operation on the 29th March 2019, introduces various new traffic management measures within Campbeltown town centre.

Modifications

The proposed parking bays on the section of Longrow South between Main Street and Union Street have been removed from the Order. This is a change to the Order as originally proposed and advertised in the Campbeltown Courier on 13th October 2017.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the 15th February 2019, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
