**ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(SINCLAIR STREET, WEST MONTROSE STREET, VICTORIA
ROAD, EAST MUNRO DRIVE/MACLACHLAN ROAD,
HELENSBURGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
ORDER 2019**



On Monday 4th February 2019, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The Order, which comes into operation on Monday 22nd March 2019, introduces a prohibition of waiting at the junctions of Sinclair Street/West Montrose Street, Sinclair Street/Victoria Road, and Sinclair Street/East Munro Drive (leading to MacLachlan Road).

Modifications

The restriction on East Munro Drive/MacLachlan Road (north side) has been reduced in length from 30 metres to 10 metres to allow additional parking at this location. This is a change to the Order as originally proposed and advertised in the Helensburgh Advertiser on 13th April 2018.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the 8th February 2019, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
