ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (PIER ROAD, DUNOON) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2018



Argyll and Bute Council proposes to make a traffic order introducing new traffic management measures on Pier Road in Dunoon. The proposals include a prohibition of all vehicles with an exception for buses; a prohibition on waiting and loading; and a one way operation. This order is required to alleviate indiscriminate parking and waiting within the bus stopping area.
