ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES AND CHARGES) (OBAN) ORDER 2018



On Monday 29th January 2018, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The Order, which comes into operation on 26th March 2018, introduces parking charges in Longsdale (Atlantis) and Lochavullin car parks and amends the existing charging regime in Ganavan car park. All three car parks will have charges applying all year round, Monday to Saturday 9am to 6pm and on Sundays 1pm to 6pm. The tariff within these car parks will be first 2 hours free and standard charges applying thereafter.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 9th February 2018, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
