ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (SALEN LOOP ROAD (UC81), SALEN, ISLE OF MULL) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2019



On Monday 14th January 2019, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The Order, which comes into operation on Monday 1st March 2019, introduces a 30mph speed restriction on the Salen Loop Road in Salen Village, Isle of Mull. The new speed limit will cover the entire length of the road.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the 18th January 2019, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
