**ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(A814 MAIN ROAD, CARDROSS)
(WAITING RESTRICTION)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2018**



On Monday 5th of February 2018, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The Order, which comes into operation on Monday 26th March 2018, introduces a prohibition on the waiting of vehicles in the layby located on Main Road at its junction with Scott Gardens.

- (iii) Argyll and Bute Council Offices, Kilmory, Lochgilphead.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from Friday the 9th of February 2018, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
