THE ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (JAMES STREET, JOHN STREET, WEST MONTROSE STREET AND SINCLAIR STREET, HELENSBURGH) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT)(AMENDMENT) ORDER 201_

Following a parking review and public consultation exercise, Argyll and Bute Council proposes to make an Order introducing new and amending existing parking restrictions in James Street, John Street, West Montrose Street and Sinclair Street in Helensburgh. The proposals are as follows:-

- 1) Change the unrestricted parking structure in John Street between West Clyde Street and West Princes Street to a 60 minutes limited waiting restriction between the hours of 0800-1800 Monday to Saturday.
- 2) Change the unrestricted parking structure in James Street between West Princes Street and West King Street to a 60 minutes limited waiting restriction between the hours of 0800-1800 Monday to Saturday.
- 3) Introduce a no waiting at any time restriction at the West Montrose Street/Sinclair Street junction.

Full details of these proposals together with Plans, and a Statement of Reasons for proposing to make this Traffic Regulation Order, are available for inspection during normal office hours Monday to Friday inclusive at the offices of:

- (i) Helensburgh and Lomond Civic Centre, East Clyde Street, Helensburgh;
- (ii) Argyll and Bute Council Offices, Kilmory, Lochgilphead.

Any person wishing to object to the proposals should send details of the grounds for objection in writing to the Head of Governance and Law, Argyll and Bute Council, Kilmory, Lochgilphead, Argyll, PA31 8RT, by 27 May 2016.
