**ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL  
(MAIN STREET, CAMPBELTOWN)  
(NO STOPPING EXCEPT TAXIS) ORDER 2018**



On Monday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2018, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The Order, which comes into operation on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2018, formalises the existing parking places for taxis. There will be two permanent parking areas on Main Street designated for taxis at the following locations; 1) on the north-west side adjacent to the Town Hall and 2) on the south-east side between Shore Street and Old Quay Head, adjacent to the Factory Shop.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from Friday the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2018, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
