### **ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND CHARGES) (OBAN) ORDER 2018**



On Monday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2018, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, which comes into operation on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2018, introduces new car parking charges in on-street parking places within Oban. The new restrictions are as follows:-

1. The first 30 minutes will be free in bays on George Street (A85 Trunk), Corran Esplanade (A85 Trunk), William Street, Queens Park Place and Argyll Square, thereafter standard charges apply.
2. New on-street parking charges on Gallanach Road (Sailing Club to Brandy Rock) and Ganavan Road (from Glenrigh to War Memorial) with charges applying 9am to 6pm Monday to Saturday and 1pm to 6pm on a Sunday.
3. Parking charges will now apply to all of the existing on-street pay and display bays on Sundays between the hours of 1pm and 6pm.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 9<sup>th</sup> February 2018, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
