ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (BUS TURNING CIRCLE, REST AND BE THANKFUL, COWAL) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2018



On Monday 23rd April 2018, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The Order, which comes into operation on Monday 11th June 2018, introduces new traffic management measures on the road known as the 'Bus Turning Circle, Rest and Be Thankful' in Cowal. The restrictions include a bus stop for local buses only; a prohibition on waiting and loading; and a one way operation.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the 27th April 2018, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
