ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES AND CHARGES) (INVERARAY) ORDER 201_



STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

Parking charges currently apply in the off street car parks in Inveraray, between 1st April and 31st October. The Council agreed in February 2016, as part of its Service Choices process, to alter the charging regime in its seasonal car parks. Following this decision, a proposal to extend the parking charges to all year round in the car parks in Inveraray was advertised in June 2016 and objections were received. The objections were not withdrawn and the proposal never progressed due to the expiry of two years beginning with the date on which the proposal was first published.

The Council subsequently agreed in February 2018, to increase parking charges and introduce additional parking charges. Following the Council decisions in both 2016 and 2018 it is proposed to introduce additional parking charges in Inveraray by extending the existing charging regime to all year round. Currently the south section of the 'Avenue Car Park' is not covered by an Order and is free to park in. This car park will remain to have no charges applying, however inclusion within this proposed Order will allow the management of this car park by restricting its use and vehicle type permitted to park.
