

ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (PIER ROAD, DUNOON) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2018

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

This order is required:-

- (i) to provide suitable and adequate stopping facilities for buses within Pier Road, Dunoon.
- (ii) to preserve and improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

A convenient and safe stopping area for buses is required to accommodate the needs of passengers travelling on the passenger ferries from Dunoon Pier. Other vehicles are making use of the area for parking and waiting which is preventing buses from having safe and convenient access.

Due to this indiscriminate parking and a lack of control, the management of the road is required to enable local buses and coaches to proceed freely and allow passengers a safe and convenient place to board and alight. This will also help to ensure that the local services can be maintained.
