STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

The Council agreed in February 2018 to introduce additional parking charges in places currently not charging to keep traffic moving, manage demand for parking and contribute to the maintenance of the roads infrastructure.

The Council are responsible for enforcing parking restrictions across Argyll and Bute. Effective traffic management has a number of benefits, including supporting the local economy by ensuring parking turnover, safeguarding access for blue badge holders, for deliveries, for loading and for emergency vehicles as well as ensuring road safety by managing inconsiderate and irresponsible parking.

A set of proposals for car parks on the Island of Mull have been agreed. The changes to the car parks and the introduction of charges are proposed to improve the management of the existing parking facilities in Mull.
